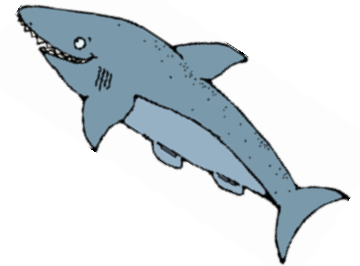

- Your team will be responsible for taking care of each of the books and rotating them to everyone on the team.
- Each member of the team will become an expert on **one** of the books.
- Each member of the team will be expected to read **at least 2** of the 5 books.
- The books will be given out at a BOB Recess Meeting when they arrive.
- Each team will have until the middle of March to read their books.
- The competition will be held March 18th through March 22nd during recess.
 - This is the week prior to Spring Break.
- Each team member will need to return a signed permission.
- Permission slips are due by Friday, October 12th.
